

# THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE TALKING DONKEY



#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Balaam knew better than to go against God and God's people, but when Balaam refused to listen to his own conscience, God made him listen to a donkey! Balaam's donkey saved Balaam's life, and if he could still speak, he would remind us all to stand with God and not against Him. Numbers 22:21-39, Balaam's Talking Donkey

"He will once again fill your mouth with laughter and your lips with shouts of joy."


